"AN ORDER AMENDING SECTION 3 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 35, SERIES OF 2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS AN ODER STRENGTHENING THE DAVAO CITY LINGAP PARA SA MAHIRAP PROGRAM, FURTHER DEFINING THE PROGRAM'S THRUST, PROVIDING FOR THE GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL ITS PROCESSES, ALLOCATING FUNDS THEREFORE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

WHEREAS, the City Government of Davao, implemented the Lingap Para sa Mahirap Program to provide medical and funeral assistance to indigent residents of Davao City;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 35, Series of 2016 provided general guidelines for the implementation of Lingap Para sa Mahirap processes and services;

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend Section 3 of EO No. 35 to further strengthen the program's processes and to ensure the efficient delivery of its services to qualified residents of Davao City;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SARA Z. DUTERTE, Mayor of the City of Davao, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the law, do hereby order the:

Section 1. Amendment of the Coverage of the Lingap sa Mahirap Program under Section 3 of Executive Order No. 35, Series of 2016.

To be excluded from Lingap Para sa Mahirap Program are as follows:

1. Those patients who are drivers or passengers in a motorcycle accident where it is found that there was fault on the part of either the driver or passenger or both by their violation of any pertinent traffic laws, rules and regulations (e.g. non-use of helmet for either or both the passenger/driver; defect in brake pads or busted lights, among others);
2. Those patients who are drivers in a vehicular accident where it is found that there was fault on the part of the driver by his violation of any pertinent traffic laws, rules and regulations;
3. Those patients who are found to be members of the New People's Army as they have already been identified as terrorists under *Proclamation No. 974 ("Declaring the New People's Army (NPA) as a Designated/Identified Terrorist Organization under Republic Act No. 10168")*, for their injuries arising from clashes with members of government troops;
4. Those patients who are drivers involved in vehicular accident where it is found that said driver is in violation of Republic Act No. 10586 ("An Act Penalizing Persons Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Dangerous Drugs, and Similar Substances, and for Other Purposes);

5. Those patients who suffer injuries while committing or a crime or an offense punishable under existing Philippine laws, rules, and regulations;
6. Those patients in maternity cases, with the exception of medical issues involving newborn babies.

Section 2. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, any part or provision not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. EFFECTIVITY.

This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full force and effect unless otherwise revoked or amended.
