EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 10
Series of 2018

"AN ORDER CREATING THE DAVAO CITY COASTAL ROAD PROJECT ADVISORY AND MONITORING BODY"

WHEREAS, Section 2, paragraph (c) of Republic Act No. 7160 or the "Local Government Code of 1991" explicitly provides that it is the policy of the State that all national agencies and offices are required "to conduct periodic consultations with appropriate local government units, nongovernmental and people's organizations, and other concerned sectors of the community before any project or program is implemented in their respective jurisdictions."

WHEREAS, Section 25, paragraph (b) of the same Code further provides "national agencies and offices with project implementation functions shall coordinate with one another and with the local government units concerned in the discharge of these functions. They shall ensure the participation of local government units both in the planning and implementation of said national projects."

WHEREAS, Section 455 paragraph (xvi) of the same Code also empowers the City Mayor to "call upon any national official or employee stationed in or assigned to the city to advise him on matters affecting the city and to make recommendations thereon; coordinate with said official or employee in the formulation and implementation of plans, programs and projects; and, when appropriate, initiate an administrative or judicial action against a national government official or employee who may have committed an offense in the performance of his official duties while stationed in or assigned to the city;"

WHEREAS, in compliance to the verbal instructions of the President of the Republic of the Philippines, Rodrigo R. Duterte, to monitor the plans, programs, as well as the implementation of the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Coastal Road Project in Davao City, there is a need to create a Body composed of persons from various sectors, both government and private;

WHEREAS, Section 18 of the same Code also authorizes local government units to establish an organization that shall be responsible for the efficient and effective implementation of their development plans, programs, objectives and priorities;

SECTION 1. CREATION AND COMPOSITION. There is hereby created the **DAVAO CITY COASTAL ROAD PROJECT ADVISORY AND MONITORING BODY** ("Body" for brevity) and the same shall be composed by the following persons and/or heads of the following offices, to wit:

All members of the Body are hereby directed to name their respective alternate and permanent representatives who shall take their place in case of their absence.

SECTION 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The Body is primarily tasked to review, assess, evaluate, and monitor the plans, programs, as well as the implementation of the DPWH Coastal Road Project ("Project" for brevity) in Davao City. It shall advocate for transparency and accountability in the implementation of the Project and accept and provide feedback from and to the public. It shall, as an independent body, come up with its comments and recommendations, or provide key information necessary for the judicious, efficient and successful implementation of the Project.

It shall advise and support the DPWH in its implementation of the Project. It may conduct consultations as it may deem warranted in order to effectively carry-out its functions.

SECTION 3. SECRETARIAT. The City Legal Office shall serve as the Body's Secretariat tasked to handle all administrative and secretarial activities. In addition, the City Engineer's Office shall provide the necessary technical administrative support to the Secretariat.

The City Administrator may hereafter identify additional City Government personnel who may be required to perform administrative support duties and functions for the successful conduct of the business, operations, and activities of the Body.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AND OPERATING COSTS. All costs pertaining to the operation of Body shall be charged to the available funds of the City Government of Davao, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
