**AN ORDER CREATING THE LUNHAW AWARDS SEARCH FOR GREEN
INITIATIVES COMMITTEE AND RECOGNIZING EVERY MONTH OF SEPTEMBER
AS LUNHAW MONTH IN DAVAO CITY**

WHEREAS, section 15, Article II of the 1987 Constitution states that the state shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, section 16, Article II of the 1987 Constitution states that the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003, also known as the Solid Waste Management Act, provides for an ecological solid waste management program, creates the necessary institutional mechanisms and incentives;

WHEREAS, section 41 of the Davao City Solid Waste Management Ordinance states that the City ENRO shall implement the incentives and rewards system under the City Solid Waste Management Plan such as cash rewards and certificates of recognition. The City ENRO shall likewise develop other incentives and rewards system for exemplary solid waste management practices;

WHEREAS, section 2 (b) Republic Act No. 9513, also known as Renewable Energy Act of 2008, provides for the increase of the utilization of renewable energy by institutionalizing the development of national and local capabilities in the use of renewable energy systems, and promoting its efficient and cost-effective commercial application by providing fiscal and non-fiscal incentives;

WHEREAS, section 53, Presidential Decree No. 1152, also known as the Philippine Environment Code, provides that the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (now DepEd) shall integrate subjects on environmental education in its school curricula at all levels. It shall also endeavor to conduct special community education emphasizing the relationship of man and nature as well as environmental sanitation and practices;

WHEREAS, section 15 of the Organic Agriculture Ordinance of Davao City states that the City shall give incentives, awards, and financial support to farmers, schools, and barangay local government units which pursue, promote, and practice organic farming;

WHEREAS, City Agriculturists' Office (CAO) is mandated to implement the Organic Agriculture Ordinance of Davao City;

WHEREAS, the Davao City Water District (DCWD) is a public utility mandated to supply safe and potable water to the entire City of Davao since 1973, pursuant Presidential Decree No. 198 as amended, as well as promote and support environmental and watershed projects;

WHEREAS, one of the strategic thrusts of Davao Association of Catholic Schools (DACS), to fully achieve its mission and vision, is through environmental innovative approaches to sustainable development, especially in the management and protection of Davao City's watersheds and recognizes the need for sustainable land use practices and strict enforcement of environmental laws and policies;

WHEREAS, in 2012, IDIS pioneered the concept of Lunhaw Awards recognizing green initiatives that promote sustainable living in Davao City in support to the environmental agenda of the LGU and requested for partnership with the above mentioned, offices and organizations;

WHEREAS, Considering the existing partnership among CENRO, CAO, DACS, DCWD and IDIS in the conduct of the Lunhaw Awards sans formal agreements to that effect, it is important that this partnership shall be formalized and be institutionalized as the award giving body;

WHEREAS, Lunhaw Awards shall not be limited to the conduct of Awarding Ceremony but shall also include preparatory and post activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SARA Z. DUTERTE, Mayor of the City of Davao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. LUNHAW AWARDS SEARCH FOR GREEN INITIATIVES IN DAVAO CITY. It is hereby declared the month of September of every year as "Lunhaw Month" in Davao City in recognition of the individuals, groups, institutions and local government units and agencies that promote environmental protection, conservation, and sustainability in keeping with the City's tagline "LIFE IS HERE".

SECTION 2. GUIDING PRINCIPLES OF THE LUNHAW AWARDS. The Lunhaw Awards recognize and honor Dabawenyo individuals and groups with exemplary and innovative initiatives in environmental management and sustainability. The Awards are open to all organizations, academic and business institutions, small groups or clubs, communities, households, and individuals, who have been practicing and engaging in green initiatives for at least two (2) years. The following criteria are applied in the criteria for judging nominees:

- Environmental Benefits – 25%
- Economic Benefits – 20%
- Sustainability – 20%
- Replicability – 15%
- Innovation – 15%
- Years of Practice – 5%

The official categories in the Lunhaw Awards are as follows:

Green Building Forest-based Initiatives Organic Agriculture Energy and Water Conservation Marine Resource Management Pollution Control Education and Advocacy

Special categories may also be identified and introduced by the Lunhaw Awards of the individuals, groups, and institutions that are promoting initiatives helpful to the environment so that their effort may be known and replicated.

SECTION 3. COMPOSITION. The Committee of the award giving body of "LUNHAW AWARDS" shall be composed of the following:

CHAIRPERSON: City Mayor
SECRETARIAT: City Environment and Natural Resources Office

MEMBERS:
City Agriculturist Office
Davao City Water District
Davao Association of Catholic Schools
Interface Development Interventions, Inc.

SECTION 4. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The Committee shall have the following duties and functions, to wit:

1. Ensure sustainable conduct of Lunhaw Awards;
2. Abide by and implement the established guidelines in the conduct of the Lunhaw Awards; -
3. Actively participate in all Lunhaw Awards events such as but not limited to annual re-launching and culminating activities;
4. Conduct on-site validation and documentation of shortlisted entries;
5. Develop and conduct promotional activities of recognized Lunhaw initiatives;

SECTION 5. CONDUCT OF THE ANNUAL LUNHAW AWARDS. The Lunhaw Awards shall be conducted every second Friday of the month of SEPTEMBER of every year.

SECTION 6. FUNDING/OPERATING COSTS - All costs pertaining to the conduct of Lunhaw Awards shall be taken from the available funds of the City Government of Davao subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Other sources of fund may be taken, with the prior approval of the Committee, from donations or from partnerships with the private sector which shall accrue to a special Trust Fund to ensure that the said funds are utilized solely for the above said purposes.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part or provision of this Executive Order shall be declared invalid, the other portions or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby, shall continue in full force and effect.

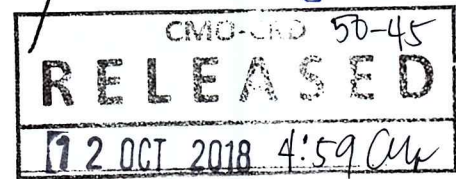
