AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MARKET COMMITTEE CREATED PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL TAX CODE AS AMENDED AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Section 17, Article 20 (Market Code) of City Ordinance No. 230, Series of 1991, as amended, otherwise known as the Tax Code of Davao City, mandates the creation of a Market Committee to formulate and implement the guidelines in the administration and operation of all public markets in Davao City;

WHEREAS, the creation of the Market Committee was subsequently modified by Executive Order No. 03, Series of 2002;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute the membership of the Market Committee in order to ensure the effective and efficient performance of its functions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **SARA Z. DUTERTE**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the membership of the Market Committee, as follows:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. – For the effective implementation of the provision of Article 20 (Market Code) Ordinance No. 230, Series of 1991, as amended, the membership of the existing MARKET COMMITTEE is hereby reconstituted and shall now be composed as follows:

Vendors – to be elected by the

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The Committee shall have the following functions:

a. Formulation of policies, rules and guidelines for market operation and admiration;

- Conduct periodic review of City market operations, and recommend appropriate actions thereon;
- Conduct the drawing of lots, raffle and opening of bids, for the adjudication of vacant or newly constructed stalls or booths in the city-owned public markets and certify the results thereof, for the approval of the City Mayor;
- Adjudicate the transfer of stallholders from one section to another or from one stall to another:
- e. Recommend such measures or actions as may be necessary and proper to the resolution of problems, in connection with the use and occupancy of stalls, booths or spaces by the city public markets;
- Organize the technical and administrative staff for the effective and efficient compliance of this Order; and,
- Enlist the assistance of Mayor's consultants, national and local agencies, nongovernment organizations, private entities and individuals.

SECTION 3. FUNDING/OPERATING COSTS. All costs pertaining to the operation of the Market Committee, including the payment of honoraria, incidental and other expenses to its members, and other appropriate personnel, as may hereinafter identified by the Chairperson or the Vice-Chairperson, shall be taken from the available funds of the City Government of Davao, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All previous Executive Orders inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately.
