**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30**

Series of 2021

**AN ORDER EXTENDING UNTIL JULY 31, 2021  
THE LIQUOR BAN AND CURFEW WITHIN THE CITY**

**WHEREAS**, the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared a COVID-19 pandemic;

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation 1021 extending the State of Calamity in the country until September 12, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) Resolution No. 113-A dated April 29, 2021 placed Davao City under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) until May 31, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, an order providing for the extension of liquor ban and curfew until May 31, 2021 was implemented as provided in Section 21 of Executive Order No. 12-B series of 2021;

**WHEREAS**, there is a surge of cases in the National Capital Region (NCR) and other areas in the country and the emergence of new COVID-19 variants;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to extend the liquor ban and curfew to regulate some activities that can contribute to local transmission in the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, SARA Z. DUTERTE**, Mayor of the City of Davao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1. EXTENSION.** The liquor ban and curfew hours are hereby extended until July 31, 2021.

The liquor ban in all public places shall be twenty-four (24) hours every day.



The curfew time in all public places is 9:00PM to 4:00AM every day, except for those who work or do business during these hours.

**SECTION 2. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

**SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All Orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

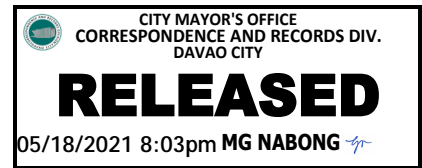
**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY.** This Order shall take effect from May 31, 2021 to July 31, 2021.
