EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15

AN ORDER CREATING THE DAVAO CITY RAPID DAMAGE ASSESSMENT AND NEEDS ANALYSIS (RDANA) TEAM, DEFINING ITS DUTIES, FUNCTIONS, AND OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Davao is prone to natural hazards such as typhoons, floods, landslides, earthquakes, monsoons, tsunamis, and other possible natural hazards. Furthermore, human-induced hazards such as fires, crimes, terrorism, and bombing have also threatened the lives of the communities;

WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs), in coordination with the Office of Civil Defense (OCD), are mandated to institutionalize the Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) as a tool for disaster response;

WHEREAS, in order to have a quick "snapshot" of the impacted areas and the general situation, thereat an RDANA Team shall be deployed in the affected areas to do an immediate assessment of the situation on the ground, specifically to: (1) determine the type and extent of damages brought about by the disaster including its secondary threats and the critical needs of the affected population and the local response capacities, (2) do information sharing among different government agencies and most importantly, (3) establish coordination among concerned agencies, stakeholders, and the community before and after every disaster at all levels.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SEBASTIAN Z. DUTERTE, Mayor of the City of Davao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. CREATION OF THE DAVAO CITY RAPID DAMAGE ASSESSMENT AND NEEDS ANALYSIS (RDANA) TEAM. There is hereby created a Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) Team to be immediately deployed after every incident, be it natural or human-induced hazards. The said team shall make an assessment during the onset of the disaster which will serve as a determining tool for the quick provision of relief and response requirements.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The Davao City Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) Team is hereby constituted as follows:

Lead Agency on Emerging and Re-emerging Infectious Diseases	City Health Office

Members:

- City Agriculturist's Office (CAgrO)
- City Veterinarian's Office (CVO)

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The RDANA Team shall have the following duties and functions:

- *Over-all Coordinator* – to immediately organize and deploy as many RDANA Teams as possible, depending on the impact and magnitude of an incident. Act as Head Secretariat to consolidate all reports from the teams.
- *Lead Agency on Families/Individuals Affected* – to assess the exact number of families and or individuals affected and to determine the number of totally and partially damaged houses.
- *Lead Agency on Agricultural Damage* – to assess the number of farmers affected and the exact damage on agricultural crops and farm animals.
- *Lead Agency Infrastructure Damage* – to assess the damages incurred, as well as determine the integrity and safety of all buildings and infrastructure.
- *Lead Agency on Poultry and Livestock Affected* – to assess the exact number of livestock raisers affected and its impact on poultry and livestock
- *Lead Agency on Emerging and Re-emerging Infectious Diseases* – to conduct assessment on the impact of a certain infectious disease and to determine its source and causes.

As a general rule, the RDANA Team shall submit immediately within 24-72 hours the assessment report on the impact of a certain incident to the City Mayor course thru the CDRRMO. Basing on the report submitted, the CDRRMO will evaluate if any of the conditions in the criteria for a declaration of state of calamity is present, then the CDRRMO will immediately convene to recommend to the City Council the declaration of a state of

calamity of a certain barangay, or the whole City of Davao if the magnitude of the disaster is wide and its impact causes considerable damage to lives and properties.

SECTION 4. FUNDING. All expenses to support the activities of the Davao City Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) Team shall be taken and sourced out from the Office of the City Mayor and or the DRRM Fund.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CAUSE. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CAUSE. All other Orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

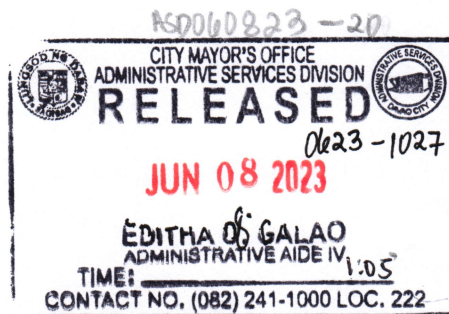
SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
